Q.1 Why some children in schools from Urban/Rural areas are not communicating in English?



Q.2 Why students are not good at writing English?



Q.4 If Yes, what is the level of difficulty you feel? And Q.5 If No what is the reason for it?





Q.6 After facing an interview what modifications are required to communicate?



Q.7 In which language you like to attend a job interview?



Q. 8 What will you do for improving your English communication?



Q. 9 Do you think education in English medium really helps students at UG and PG level?



Q. 10 Which language do you prefer to your education?


